### Packing Away//

We strongly recommend that you do not disconnect your lines from your kite and handles or bar.

**Handles:** Take both handles together in one hand and wind the lines around the foam grips.

**Bar:** Hold the bar in one hand and wind lines around the bar in a figure-of-8 motion.

**Important:** To avoid twists in the lines, it is vital that the next time you use your kite, you unwind the lines in the same way as you wound them on; i.e. the unwinding action must be the exact reverse of the winding action.
