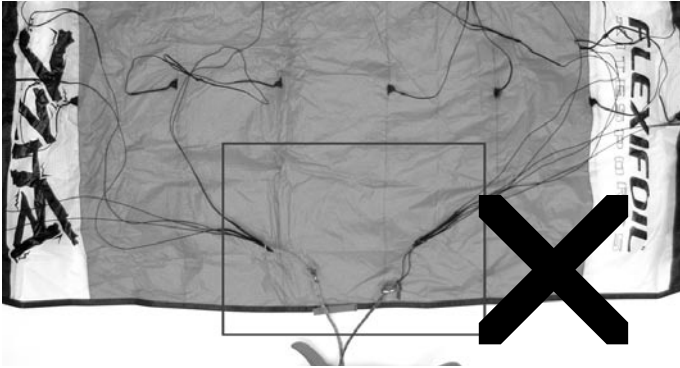
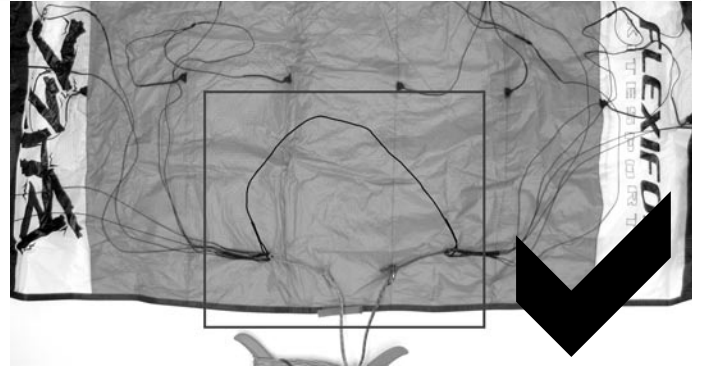


## Attaching the Limiter Line



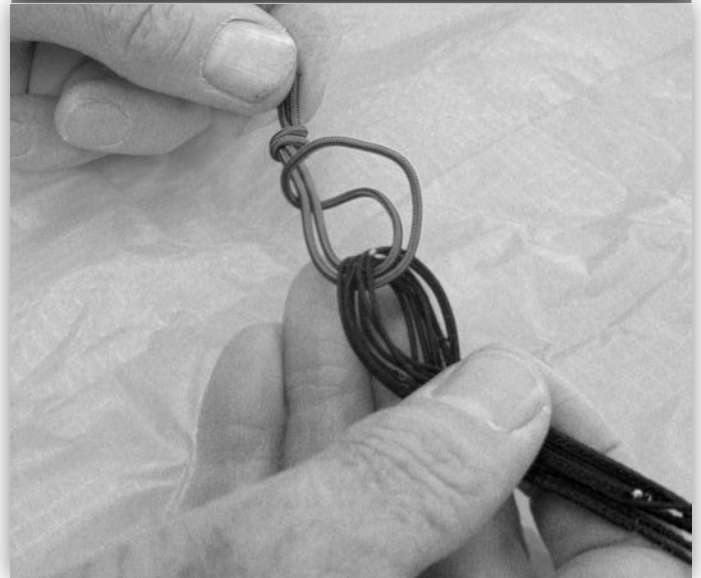

**fig. 1** - Detach the flying lines from the bridle toggles.



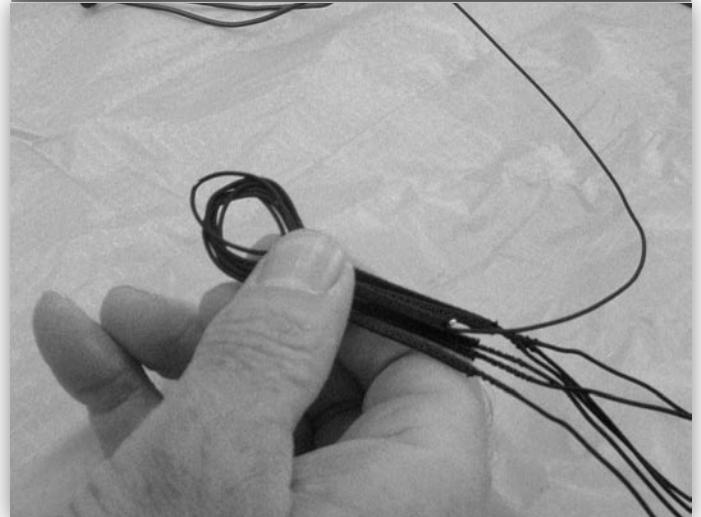
**fig. 2** - Detach the bridle toggle from the bridles. Simply loosen the larkhead knot and remove.

**fig. 4** - Add the limiter line loop next to the bridle line loops. The limiter line should run in the same direction as the other bridle lines.

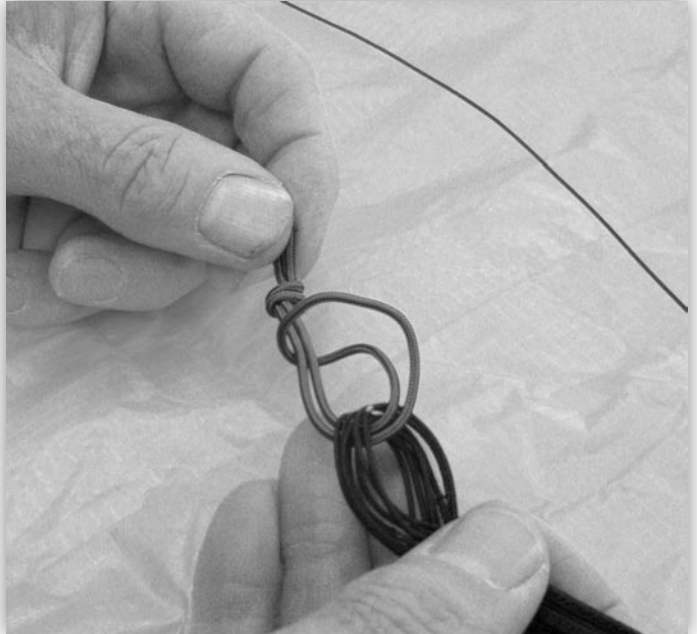
## Attaching the Limiter Line

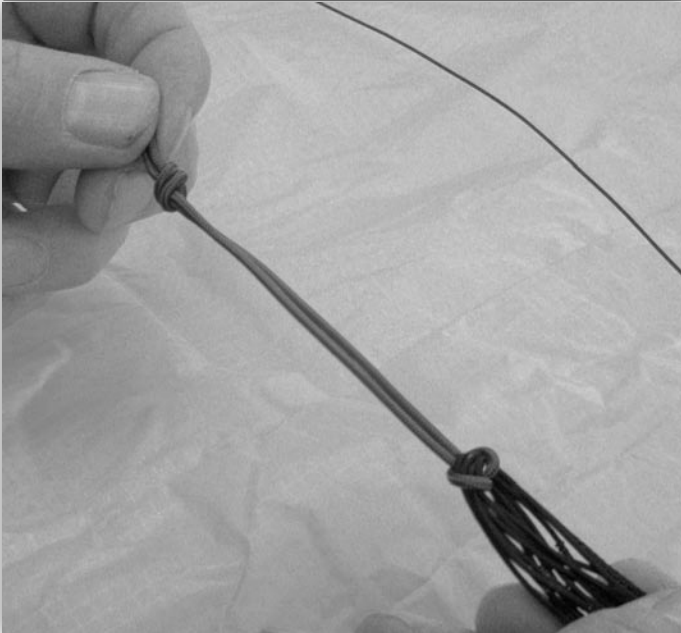
**fig. 5** - Thread the bridle toggle back through the bridle line loops and the limiter line loop.
